Welcome to the LCFL! Legendary entertainer and philanthropist, Patti LaBelle endorses this league, which launched in Philadelphia Pennsylvania in the fall of 2003. Other league supporters include former NFL football player and NBC anchor, Maurice Spence, Ray Lewis and Mark Clayton of the Baltimore Ravens, Donovan McNabb of the Philadelphia Eagles, Terrell Owens of the Buffalo Bills, and Adalius Thomas of the New England Patriots. These NFL greats support the LCFL, and are currently working together to create a minor league community football system in the United States. With Philadelphia as the Mecca, the league will establish regions throughout the country. Southern California came on board in 2005 and now has 20 franchises to its credit. Teams range from Inglewood, Reseda, Orange County, Chino Hills, Palm Springs, Long Beach, San Diego, and Oceanside to name a few. Additionally, the LCFL expanded in 2009 with 6 teams in the North and South Eastern United States. The LCFL hopes to become a nationwide organization that will help empower its players, and give positive representation to their communities.
